VINYL WINDOWS CARE AND CLEANING

INTRODUCTION

This guide provides important information that will help to keep vinyl windows and patio doors looking beautiful and operating smoothly for many years. Vinyl products contain ultraviolet (UV) inhibitors designed to reduce sun damage. Vinyl is manufactured to be low maintenance and long lasting without the need for painting or finishing.

CLEANING RECOMMENDATIONS

- Clean twice a year or when dirty.
- Avoid using metal tools, razor blades, or sharp objects and abrasive cleaners. They can damage window surfaces.
- Avoid cleaning in direct sunlight or in temperatures too hot or too cold.

SCREEN CLEANING

1. Remove screen and gently spray with water and brush lightly with soft bristle brush until clean.
2. Reinstall screen when dry.

VINYL SURFACE CLEANING

1. Rinse surface with clean water from top to bottom.
2. Clean with mild soap and water and sponge or soft brush.
3. Promptly rinse thoroughly with clean water.
4. Wipe dry with lint-free, dry cloth.

GLASS CLEANING

1. Rinse surface with clean water from top to bottom.
2. Clean with mild soap and water and sponge or soft brush.
3. Promptly rinse thoroughly with clean water.
4. Wipe dry with lint-free, dry cloth.
